Background

LawnPro Mossclear quickly and effectively kills moss in lawns without harming lawn grasses. It also kills moss spores to stop moss coming back.

Benefits and Features

Application

Directions

1) Dilution

- a. **Light moss** – Dilute 50 ml in 1 L water and apply to moss – Covers 24 m²
- b. **Heavy/dense moss** – Dilute 100 ml in 1 L and apply to moss – Covers 12 m²

2) Apply diluted Mossclear to moss using pressure sprayer or watering can.

3) Once the moss is dead, rake dead moss out of lawn and aerate the soil with a fork.

For Best Results

- Apply LawnPro 7 Day Green to the lawn to 'sweeten' the soil and raise the pH. It also helps strengthen the lawn grass to shade out the moss.
- Cut back shading plants and reseed lawn if required.
- Best applied in Autumn/early Winter before moss becomes too dense.
- Use Kiwicare Dye & Stick for improved performance and to help track the areas sprayed.
- Do not treat moss during freezing or drought conditions.
- Mossclear can be used on paths and hard surfaces but may stain light coloured surfaces. We recommend Kiwicare's outdoor cleaning product SORTED Moss & Mould.

Caution

- Avoid applying if lawn is under stress or suffering from drought.
- Apply in calm weather to avoid drift onto desirable plants.
- If composting lawn clippings, do not use compost for 6 months.
- May stain paths, paving, slabs tiles, decking and clothing.
- Avoid contact with skin, may cause irritation.
- Do not inhale, may cause respiratory irritation.
- Wear protective clothing and gloves when using.
- Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
